Membership Responsibilities

All members are expected to participate in Committee activities. Each member will be monitored from time to time to gauge effectiveness. Total membership will be reviewed each calendar year.

Committee Deliverables / Outputs and Schedule

Deliverables:

1. Send survey to Council members requesting safety topics they would like to see available.
2. Utilize survey data to define additional deliverables.
3. Enhance WCCC website with the addition of a "Safety" tab to house all safety related training and information.

Schedule: Every two weeks.

Each year a new Steering Sub-Committee will be appointed. The Sub-Committee will develop an annual agenda and objectives for the committee.

Decision Making Process

Decisions are made by a majority of the members present at any meeting. Decisions by the Steering Sub-Committee must have concurrence at a subsequent full committee meeting. Full committee may empower the Committee Chairman to make certain decisions.
